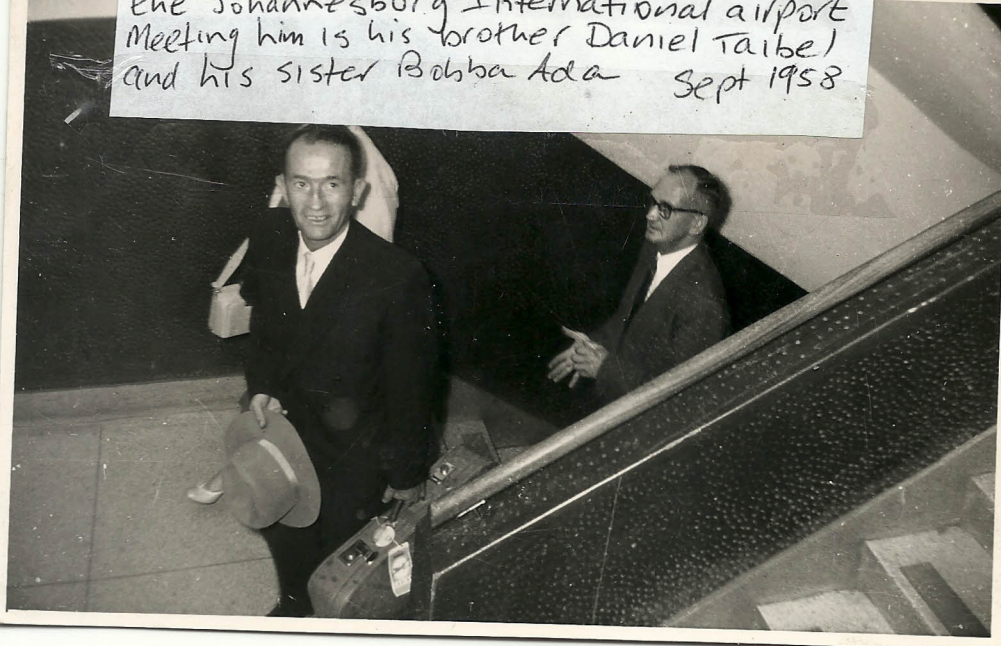


"Dead" brother is now alive

The man in dark suit (right), Mr. Leibe Taibel, burst into tears at Jan Smuts airport last night and then he collapsed. He had just arrived from Israel. Mr. Taibel, who is 50, escaped from behind the Iron Curtain where, in Lithuania, he had seen his seven brothers and his mother killed. In silence he is clutched by his sole surviving brother, Mr. Daniel Taibel, who left Lithuania before the last war and had long given Leibe up for dead. On the left is his sister Mrs. Ada Wainberg of Tenth Avenue, Orange Grove, Johannesburg. Mr. Taibel escaped last year and found refuge in Israel. Now he is to start a new life in Johannesburg.
